- 1) Meeting called to order, outline of agenda announced, program rules outlined
- 2) 30 minute Power Point Presentation by Dr. Owen outlining:
 - a. STLDCD organizational structure, members, and legal representation
 - b. 5 flood mitigation areas are to be examined by the MRC pre STLDCD resolution
 - i. Potential Levee alignments and extensions
 - ii. Fritche Marsh restoration
 - iii. Rigolets Surge Barrier options
 - iv. Hwy 90/190 barrier options
 - v. Shoring options and other dwelling protection options
 - c. An overview of flooding that occurred from 1979—2023 via different mechanisms: Pearl River overflow; Rainwater events; Hurricane surge.
 - d. Mechanisms of flooding along the Doubloon Bayou drainage system were reviewed from aerial photos and potential future flooding was reviewed based on development and engineering operations along the Bayou.
- 3) Question and answer session followed for 90 additional minutes.
- 4) Meeting adjourned at 8 pm.
