Dear Ms. Krieger:

During the 2009 legislative session, Act 12 provided additional accountability and transparency for Louisiana's regulatory boards and commissions. The act directed the Commissioner of Administration to "establish and maintain a website to post the information designated" by the act. As a result, the Division of Administration created the Boards and Commissions database (http://www.cford.doa.louisiana.gov/boardsAndCommissions/home.cfm) within its LaTrac website and opened it to the required regulatory boards and commissions.

Later, Act 814 of 2010 expanded these filing requirements to include each board and commission whose members are required to file annual financial disclosure statements pursuant to R.S. 42:1124.2.1, which greatly increased the number of boards and commissions required to file and maintain the information on this website.

In addition, R.S. 24:513.2 requires the Legislative Auditor to establish and maintain a comprehensive computerized information system on all state boards, commissions, and like entities.

In an effort to streamline these two filing requirements, the Division of Administration and the Legislative Auditor formed a cooperative endeavor in 2010 that allows the satisfactory filing of the required information on the Division's Boards and Commissions website to also fulfill the annual filing requirements of the Legislative Auditor.

Subsequently, Act 184 of 2013 instituted greater penalties for boards who fail to provide the required information. Failure to comply could ultimately result in your board's termination by the Legislature in the next year. In addition, your board could be subject to being reported as noncompliant in the Louisiana Legislative Auditor's annual report to the legislature on boards and commissions. Please help us avoid such measures by timely submitting your information to us.
